South Garden Estates Neighborhood Reconstruction

Dear Resident,

Today crews continue installing storm sewer on West Shore Drive north of Andover Road. This work should be wrapped by the end of the day. They will have the roadway closed from W. 70th St. to Andover Road while this work is being done. Please use Wooddale, as it will be your best access in and out of the neighborhood.

Crews have completed work on your new concrete aprons and driveways on West Shore Drive and Andover Road. Please follow the 7 day required cure period to keep your warranty in effect. You will be notified by the crews when vehicle access is granted back onto your driveway.

Wednesday, crews will move to replace the last 2 fire hydrants on Belvidere Lane. Crews will need to shut off the water on Belvidere to install these 2 new fire hydrants. An orange tag will be placed on your front door in advance to forewarn you of the shutdown. Shut downs will not begin until after 8:00 am. Crews will have the water on as soon as they possibly can. This should be the last of the water shut downs in the neighborhood. On Wednesday, crews will be grading the rest of West Shore Drive north of Andover Road. Crews plan on back hauling gravel to fill the roadway back in as they dig it out. Again, please use Wooddale as access will be tight.

Thursday and Friday, crews will be doing curb and gutter and driveways on the rest of West Shore Drive north of Andover Road.

Early next week, crews will be working on shaping the gravel roadway surface on Belvidere and West Shore Drive, and Andover Road as well as backfilling behind the new curb and gutter. Crews plan on paving the rest of the neighborhood sometime late next week with the first layer of blacktop.

Reminder: If you currently have an irrigation system or a pet fence, it may get damaged during construction. If your system is damaged from construction, the contractor has a kit to plug the damaged area so the rest of your irrigation will still work. Once the curb and gutter has been installed, and the black dirt backfilled behind the new curb, we can begin the process of repairing the irrigation systems and pet fences. We will have your company fix the damage, and the City of Edina will take care of the bill for you. However, the City will only pay for these repairs on a one time basis.

Please remind all children to stay away from all reconstruction operations, parked equipment, and stockpiled supplies. For everyone's safety, if you see anything onsite that looks out of place or someone that doesn't belong please call the City of Edina Police Department. They have been informed of this, and are keeping a close eye on the site for us, but your help would be greatly appreciated if you see anything out of place.

Please remember this schedule is weather dependent and therefore, can change on a daily basis. As always, please feel free to contact me if you have any questions.
