Parkwood Knolls Neighborhood Reconstruction

Dear Resident,

I want to clear up questions received about mail and mail box locations and mail delivery.

Residents living in phase 1 - (South Knoll Drive, Knoll Drive, Idylwood Lane and part of Schaefer Road up to Idylwood Lane intersection)

Remember, On Wednesday May 5th, residents living in phase 1 will have their mail delivered to the temporary mail box locations. Please refer to the map that was hand delivered yesterday for specific information as to location of your temporary mail box.

Residents who have a mail box on Schaefer Road, but live in Phase 1, will continue to receive mail at their normal mail box location as this area is delivered by the mail carrier in Phase 2.

Crews will begin working on repairing sanitary sewer mains on Wednesday. This work will take place in the center of the streets. Crews will section off the areas needing repairs with barricades. Please do not drive around the barricades unless you live within the area being repaired. If you have any questions, feel free to ask any crew member for assistance. Crews plan on working most of Wednesday at the intersection of South Knoll Drive and Blake Road. This area should be re-opened by days end. Crews will then move on to Knoll Drive to work on other sewer repairs in that area.

Residents living in Phase 2 – CenterPoint Energy and Michels will continue working on the gas main on your street. This work will take approximately 3 weeks to complete.

Please remind all children to stay away from all construction operations, parked equipment, and stockpiled supplies. For everyone's safety, if you see anything onsite that looks out of place or someone that doesn't belong please call the City of Edina Police Dept. They have been informed of this project, and are keeping a close eye on the site for us, but your help would be greatly appreciated if you see anything out of place.
