STAGE UPDATES

Stages 6B-10

Please refer to Palda's bi-weekly progress map for a description of upcoming work except as modified below.

Streets, Sidewalks, Driveways, and Boulevards

During the week of November 2, Palda will begin installing the blacktop control joints. The joints control where cracks form in the new pavement. All blacktop pavement in cold-weather climates, such as the Country Clubs, crack when they endure freeze-thaw cycles in the weather.

Palda will use large saws to begin to cut these joints into the final layer of blacktop pavement. Palda will create dust when they operate the saws. The sawing will not take very long to complete.

Palda will inform you in advance of the actual day they will saw the joints into the pavement in front of your house using a door knob hanger. On that day, you must **not** park on your street. Otherwise, you will be in Palda's way. Please pass this message along to any contractors that might be working at your home during the week of November 2.

Palda will also post temporary no parking signs on that day on your particular street. Palda will ask the Police department to have any vehicle, including your contractor's vehicles, violating this temporary parking restriction ticketed and towed.

Clean up

During the next few weeks, Palda will continue cleaning up the streets and boulevards in the project area before leaving the project. They will also clean up their material storage area in Wooddale Park to the satisfaction of the City.
